Stooping & bending forward from standing position					✓		Frequent requirement to stoop / bend forward from standing position. This posture is assumed and completed on a repetitive basis, particularly whilst: Shovelling Sweeping using broom Manoeuvring bluestones Pouring cold mix into potholes Utilising key to leverage / remove pit lids Removing wedges which secure the street sign poles
Kneeling / squatting					√		Frequent requirement to kneel and/or squat. This posture is assumed and completed on a repetitive basis particularly whilst: Lifting / carrying bluestones from the ground Resetting bluestones Manoeuvring bluestones Pouring cold mix into potholes

Walking over uneven surfaces					√		Frequent requirement to walk over uneven surfaces. This includes areas in which bluestones have been removed, as well as nature strips within the community
Ladder climbing					√		Frequent requirement to climb ladders to access high street signage. Note: ladder climbing is not required whilst completing: Bluestone / Laneway repair, Pit Lid Cleaning and Drainage Maintenance Pot Hole repair / Patchwork (make safe)

Exposure to vibration	~		Occasional exposure to vibration. Workers are subject to vibration whilst utilising: Wackerplate through the upper limbs Jackhammers Note: whilst completing Bluestone repair, workers would be exposed to vibration on rare occasions when required to use an angle grinder for the purposes of to cutting larger bluestones which are too heavy to handle using upper limbs. Whilst completing Pit Lid Cleaning and Drainage Maintenance tasks, workers would not be exposed to any vibration

	Concentration	✓	High levels of concentration required, particularly whilst: Driving work vehicle Utilising heavy machinery Whilst attending to hazardous tasks (see identified hazards section of report)
	Patience	✓	Workers are required to exercise high levels of patience whilst attending to complex tasks
Personal	Emotional stability	✓	Workers are required to have a developed emotional stability whilst completing tasks
	Judgement	√	Workers are required to exercise good judgement whilst completing all aspects of the role. This is particularly important given the nature of the role and associated hazards (see identified hazards section of report)
	Reasoning	✓	Workers are required to exercise sound reasoning whilst completing all aspects of the role. The ability to identify issues and address these using appropriate tools and processes is necessary
	Isolation	-	All aspects of the role are completed with the assistance / accompaniment of a colleague, with the exception of Street sign maintenance; this task is completed in isolation.
	Autonomy	✓	Workers are able to utilise autonomy with respect to the processes in which they complete a task, however have no autonomy with respect to the work which is allocated to them by their supervisor
	Peer support	√	All aspects of the role are completed with the assistance / accompaniment of a colleague. As such peer support is available for all tasks with the exception of Street sign maintenance; this task is completed in independently
Social	Social network	✓	A social network is available for all Infrastructure Maintenance Officer.
	Production demands	✓	Workers are allocated a number of jobs per day with an expectation that this is completed. Should allocated jobs take longer than expected, these are completed the following day. Review of productivity and worker progress with allocated tasks is carried out on a regular basis.
	Stress	✓	Workers may be exposed to potentially stressful situations, particularly with respect to irate members of the community. On rare occasions, workers may encounter such situations whilst completing their tasks. It is expected that the worker would not engage in such confrontations.
